INTRODUCTION



STUDENTS FEEDBACK 2016-17



Analysis of students feedback on the curriculum is presented below:
















































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







Graph 4.1 The academic progress of the student









Graph 1.4 Modern teaching aids are used by most of the teachers while teaching

































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


















































































1. Does the syllabus reflect current requirements of content?






